The Orient Queen is the first five stars ship that embarked from Beirut through all the Mediterrenean sea.

In 2004, the new owner wanted to renovate the ship by changing all its glass. Many companies tried to accomplish the work needed but failed. Using the stain removers and the rite polish, some demonstrations were done on different pieces of glass that were harmfully stained and contaminated.
